## About this Agreement:

Luzerne County Community College and Marywood University have agreed to a correlation of their curricula for students in the Associate in Applied Science: Architectural Engineering Technology degree program at Luzerne County Community College who wish to complete the the Bachelor of Architecture (B. Arch) at Marywood University. Subject to the terms of this agreement, a student who satisfactorily completes the requirements of the AAS degree at Luzerne County Community College with a 3.0 grade point average or above, will be granted admission to Marywood University and will have his/her credits earned with a grade of 'C' or better, accepted for transfer based on the articulation agreement equivalency (see below). However, the following terms and conditions shall apply:

- 1) A total of 162 credits are required for the B. Arch professional degree (five years) at Marywood University.
- 2) Transfer students must complete a minimum of 30 credits at Marywood.
- 3) LCCC students who wish to enter the degree program must have a 3.0 overall QPA on a minimum of 12 credits in one of these two disciplines. A minimum QPA of 2.5 is required in all degree tracks for a student to be in good academic standing.
- 4) LCCC students who wish to enter the degree program must submit a portfolio of design work, including work done for course credit and, if applicable, non-credit baring work.
- 5) All LCCC students must enroll in, and successfully complete, a sequence of two summer Transition Design Studios (six credits each) at Marywood.
- 6) This agreement is to be used as a guide only. Marywood University cannot guarantee that the needed courses will be offered in a given semester.
- 7) The University estimates that a student can earn her/his B. Arch degree in six semesters and two summer sessions provided s/he follows the conditions and requirements of this articulation agreement.
- 8) The University estimates that a student can earn her/his BARCH degree in six semester and two summer sessions provided s/he follows the conditions and requirements of this articulation agreement.
- 9) The student must meet all deadline dates for application to the University, payment of fees, and any other deadlines as they apply to all new students at Marywood.
- 10) The student shall choose the recommended elective courses and course sequences as shown on the articulation agreement.
- 11) The student must not attend another institution of higher education in the time between graduating from Luzerne County Community College and enrolling at Marywood University.

If any of the above terms and conditions are not met, Marywood University shall determine the appropriate number of transfer credits on an individual basis.

Students who wish to transfer to Marywood University prior to obtaining their Associate's degree from Luzerne County Community College must submit their official transcript for a course-by-course evaluation.

This agreement may be terminated at any time by either Marywood University or Luzerne County Community College via a written notice thirty days in advance of the effective date of termination. It is understood that any termination will not apply to students who have already started the AAS degree program at Luzerne County Community College or the Bachelor of Architecture program at Marywood University.
